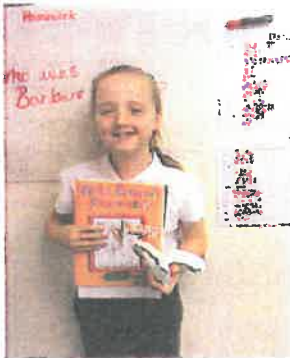
## **Girl's Toilet Trouble**
